2019/01383/FUL

Location: Land at former Plasnewydd Farm, Cowbridge Road, Llantwit Major

Proposal: Variation of Condition 26 of Planning Permission 2014/00831/FUL to facilitate phased delivery of

the LAP and LEAP

**Objection:** The Planning Committee noted that people had bought houses on the former Plasnewydd

Farm site in good faith subject to the original Planning Condition which approved a LEAP and LAP. The Planning Committee see no reason to delay this part of the build and therefore this new Application should not be granted. Location: Corner House, Stag Lane, Llantwit Major

Proposal: Amended plans: New window and cooker extract flue to existing A3 use

To discuss letter from WYG Environment Planning Transport Ltd re preapplication consultation re the proposed development for

a) Up to 140 homes on Land east of B4265, Llantwit Major - Site A

b) Up to 100 homes on Land north of West Camp, Llantwit Major - Site B

The Planning Committee discussed this proposed pre application consultation and agreed a letter be written to WYG Environment Planning Transport Ltd detailing the following comments as previously sent to WYG following the Public exhibition to the proposed residential site on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2019. These being:

- 1. The impact on the infrastructure to Llantwit Major with reference to this proposed development and the ongoing housing estates being built in Llantwit Major and the surrounding areas as detailed in the LDP. There is up to 1000 new residential houses built in Llantwit Major and the surrounding area over the coming few years.
- 2. Local schools in Llantwit Major are already reaching their capacity. The Town Council have concerns that this development could cause overcrowding within the Local Schools in Llantwit Major. Llantwit Major Learning Community is the feeder school for Llantwas and St Athan.
- 3. The impact on the already busy Medical Facilities within Llantwit Major.
- 4. The impact on the Leisure Centre / Green Spaces within the town.
- 5. The increase traffic and the impact on the parking within the town. It is already difficult to find a parking spot in the town centre.
